**Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup>** is Victoria Day so school will not be in session. Enjoy the long weekend!



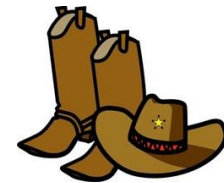
### Paint Party at the School
